

Sun Metals Corporation – Zinc Refinery Expansion Project

Hurst Constructions Queensland supported the \$455M expansion of Sun Metals Corporation Zinc Refinery by delivering a fit out of an electrical building, furic oxide building and storage sheds. The expansion supports SunMetals' progress toward increasing annual zinc production in the region from 50,000 tonnes to 300,000 tonnes p/a.

Gibb Group - Queensland Health Warehouse

Hurst Constructions Queensland have constructed a new warehouse facility at the Bohle for Queensland developer; Gibb Group. The 5000m² tilt-panel structure will be used by Queensland Health as a storage facility.

Approximately 60,000 tonnes per year of iron oxide, containing approximately 50% iron, is produced by the Sun Metals zinc refining process, within the ferric oxide plant. The iron oxide is suitable for use in a range of industries including cement, steel, paint and pigment manufacture.
